**Previous Restoration Activities -**

With the exception for areas within the Withlacoochee North and Suwannee River bottoms located on Twin Rivers State Forest, there is very limited opportunity for wetland restoration work on Twin Rivers/Big Shoals State Forests. Projects listed on the *FERI* website involve invasive exotic plant control, including cooperative management efforts with partnering agencies to control Japanese and Old World Climbing fern (*Lygodium spp*). Invasive exotic species control is an on-going activity on all the State Forests.

**Current/Planned/Proposed Restoration Activities –**

No restoration activities are being conducted on either Forest at this time. At the time of this writing, no restoration projects have been proposed or planned for either State Forest for the immediate future.

**Wetland Restoration Needs Assessment –**
