

CERTIFIED PRESCRIBED BURN MANAGER (CPBM) VIOLATIONS - POINT ASSESSMENT TABLE

1.	Any burn initiated outside of planned prescription parameters based upon morning forecast (For example, wind speed, RH, dispersion, temperature, etc.).	Five (5) Points
2.	Certified Prescribed Burn Manager obtains an authorization knowingly using false information (For example, Lat./Long. S-T-R, Certified burn number, equipment on site, personnel).	Fifteen (15) points
3.	Fire escapes from the prescribed area and does not cause damage to property/improvements of persons other than the landowner.	Three (3) points
4.	The Division of Forestry or other emergency response agency is required to take suppression action.	Two (2) points
5.	Failure to pay suppression charges for an escaped burn within 15 days of receipt of second notice from DOF.	Three (3) points
6.	Failure to pay an administrative fine or request an administrative hearing within 21 days of receipt of notice of action.	One (1) point per infraction
7.	Improper smoke screening (Burner does not identify or mitigate for smoke sensitive areas).	Two (2) points
8.	Certified Prescribed Burn Manager burns without obtaining an authorization.	Fifteen (15) points
9.	Failure to attempt to shut down a burn after notification from DOF.	Five (5) points
10.	Fire escapes from the prescribed area and causes damage to the property/improvements of persons other than landowner.	Five (5) points
11.	Certified Prescribed Burn Manager who attempts to burn without a written prescription at the site of burn while burn is being conducted.	Five (5) points
